



LINDHURST HIGH SCHOOL SECURITY INFORMATION RELEASE AND AGREEMENT FORM

Lindhurst High School welcomes adult students to Lindhurst High School for the Culinary Art 3A, Engineering10 and Computer 10L class. As guests of Lindhurst High School, all adult students must meet specific requirements to gain admission to Lindhurst High School. For the safety of our younger student population, Lindhurst High has implemented stringent security measures in the approval process and daily procedures relating to adult student access to Lindhurst High School.

After reading the information below, all adult students are required to provide signature and a valid Driver’s License or State Identification number to the School Attendance Office.

- Adult students enrolled in Lindhurst High School classes are required to submit a valid Driver’s License or State Identification number during the first day of enrollment. The student name, residency status and driver’s license number will be submitted to Marysville Joint Unified School District. Marysville Joint Unified School District will complete a security check on each student, running the identification number through police channels, searching for outstanding wants and warrants. **Students with outstanding wants and warrants will be denied access to Lindhurst High School and may face arrest if attempting to enter.**
- Adult students may obtain a daily visitor pass prior to the beginning of the term.
- Adult students will be allowed to enter Lindhurst through the front Main Gate (Olive Avenue) entrance only.
- When entering school grounds, adult students will be required to park in the visitor parking lot, walk to the Attendance Office and present the following:
 - Current student schedule
 - Photo identification (current driver’s license)
 - Current vehicle registration
 - Proof of insurance

Upon verifying proper documentation, LHS Personnel will issue a daily temporary visitor pass, allowing the adult student to enter the school premise. The student will then be required to report directly to the class. The adult students will be required to check in to the Attendance Office and obtain a daily pass prior to the start of each class.

- While on Lindhurst High School premises, adult students must proceed directly to the enrolled class when traveling to and from class. The adult students will not deviate from the direct route of travel or attempt to access Lindhurst High facilities or instructor(s) during this period. Adult students who deviate from the direct route of travel, lose student access privileges to Lindhurst High School. If an adult student is caught out of the direct route of travel, the student access privileges to Lindhurst High School will be revoked and escorted off school premise.
