Coach Rod is entering his second season as head coach of the 49ers! A 1985 graduate of Yuba City High School, Coach Rod is our “homegrown” baseball coach, who had the luxury to play for and coach with the best coaches in California! Joe Graben, Gary Engelken, Jim Stassi, Rich McKray and Ramiro Carreon. Coach Rod is an “Original 49er” playing shortstop for legendary head coach Gary Engelken.

Coach Rod coached high school baseball at Yuba City HS for 32 years. During his tenure as varsity head coach, Rod won 7 league Championships and 2 Sac-Joaquin Division III Section titles. He was honored three times for league coach of the year. He has complied a total of 237 wins. His play-off record was 12 wins and 5 loses a .705 winning percentage.

2024 he was recognized and Honored for his tenure as assistant and head coach for over 30 years by the California Baseball Coaches Association

2023, Coach Rod's American Legion Baseball team won the California State Championship and represented California in the American Legion Western Regional Tournament.

2020 he was named the State of California High School Coach of Year.

14 Former players have signed MLB contracts and over 60 have

played collegiately.

Coach Rod's program was honored by the California Legislature Assembly Resolution in 2015, as well, as a Proclamation from the City of Yuba City in the same year.

He has hosted several baseball community events, coaching clinics, parent baseball seminars, umpire clinics and has donated his time and facilities to the community. His teams are actively involved in the community as they received the CIF Community Service Award in 2014. Coach Rod also volunteers his time for Baseball in San Quentin Prison.

Coach Rod was honored in 2023 by Yuba City High School when his number "4" was retired.
