**Prerequisites:**

1. Must be eligible for admission to the University.
2. Eligibility for admission to the RN to BSN Nursing major:
  - Graduation from an associate degree program in nursing (can be in final semester).
  - 54 transferrable non-nursing units (GE certification courses, Nursing prerequisites & co-requisites).
  - Completion of CSU, Chico lower division GE requirements.
  - Completion of all CSU, Chico Nursing prerequisite courses (Anatomy, Physiology, Microbiology, Chemistry, Oral Communication, Written Communication, Critical Thinking, & Statistics) with minimum “C” grade.
  - Cumulative GPA of 3.0 (will accept most recent 60 units); 3.0 in Nursing is required to apply before graduation
  - Must be accepted into the RN to BSN Program by the School of Nursing before applying to CSU, Chico.
