**Starting Fall 2024, all new Yuba College Students must complete a General Education Ethnic studies course as a graduation requirement. Continuously enrolled Yuba College students (did not take off a Fall/Spring semester consecutively) since before Fall 2024, may not have this requirement mandated.

Minimum 2.50 GPA must be earned in all courses (aggregate) for sections a and b below to apply.

a. Anatomy, Physiology, and Microbiology combined GPA

b. English, Statistics, chemistry, Nutrition, Psychology, humanities, sociology/anthropology, speech combined GPATEAS exam score of 67 or higher is needed to qualify for admission.

Yuba College Nursing utilizes a Multi-Criteria Screening Process to score and rank program applicants. Course prerequisites, preadmission testing, and transcript submission must be completed prior to submitting an application. All application instructions, materials, guidelines, deadlines, and evaluation tools are available at nursing.yccd.edu. Potential applicants are strongly encouraged to become familiar with and utilize these resources to ensure their application is complete and complies with all current requirements.

Applications will be accepted twice a year, and the top 30 applicants (30 students fall/spring semester) will be selected to enroll in the upcoming academic year. In addition, 15 alternates notified each semester. If applicant is not selected, they are welcome to apply to the next application cycle.
