Yuba College Nursing utilizes a Multi-Criteria Screening Process to score and rank program applicants. Course prerequisites, preadmission testing, and transcript submission must be completed prior to applying. All application instructions, materials, guidelines, deadlines, and evaluation tools are available at nursing.yccd.edu. Potential applicants are strongly encouraged to become familiar with and utilize these resources to ensure their application is complete and complies with all current requirements.

Applications will be accepted twice a year, and the top 30 applicants (30 students fall/spring semester) will be selected to enroll in the upcoming academic year. In addition, 15 alternates each semester. If an applicant is not selected, they are welcome to apply in the next application cycle.
