<p>Proof of the following items will not be required to enroll in EMT 61. However, during your first session (or scheduled date with instructor) you must be able to present proof. <u>Proof of vaccinations can be found on childhood shot records.</u> More information will be available in your course syllabus.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Must be 18 years old by the time you are scheduled for your clinical hours. If you will not be 18 by the time you enroll; please contact the office to verify your DOB and clinical dates.</li> <li>• MMR Vaccine – Documented two (2) MMR shots or a Positive Titer Test</li> <li>• Hep B Vaccine – Documented three (3) total shots. Or, student sign Rideout HepB Declination Form</li> <li>• Tetanus/Diphtheria Vaccine (Tdap) – Documented shot – within ten (10) years from semester term date</li> <li>• TB Skin Test – Test must be within twelve (12) months and not expire during the program duration</li> <li>• Varicella Vaccine – Documented two (2) shots or a Positive Titer Test</li> <li>• Flu Shot – Current flu season (Nov-March). Documented shot or Sign Rideout Flu Declination Form</li> </ul>

At this point, your credit card <u>will be charged \$45.00.</u></li> <li>○ You will be emailed a unique log in code which will allow you to access to retrieve a copy of your and manager your account through Verify Student (link above).</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>10-Panel Drug Screen</b> will be completed at Fremont/Rideout Occupational Health.
