Step 2:	<p>Complete the Online Application (Step 1): Completing the <u>Yuba College</u> Application does not confirm Academy Attendance. Step 3:	<p>Medical Clearance: Due by May 1, 2021</p> <p>It is necessary to obtain a medical clearance from a physician. The medical clearance is required to provide reasonable assurance that there is no medical reason why you should not participate in the program. And, medical clearance must be obtained at your own expense. <u>This clearance</u> needs to be 6-months current.</p> <p>If you are agency affiliated, a letter from your chief providing medical clearance will be accepted.</p> <p>REQUIRED APPLICATION FORMS:</p> <p>HealthHistoryStatement-ParQ. (complete prior to seeing your physician). This form is NOT needed back; doctor review ONLY.</p> <p>Medical-Release-form – You may go to your own physician or any Urgent Care facility to obtain clearance. Note: not all insurances will cover a physical. This fee may be expected at the time you are seen by the physician and can vary in cost.</p>
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Please submit Academy Applications as a complete packet. Candidates will receive a letter of acceptance to continue forward for medical clearance and enrollment process.

Public Safety Staff will do the following once packets are received, reviewed & approved:

- Clear the block to allow student’s final enrollment process
- Notify or assist students with enrollment process: [PortalGuard - Portal Access \(yccd.edu\)](#)
 - * Fees must be paid 10-day, BOGW approved, or payment plan must be established
 - * Agency will be invoiced to allow time for purchase order – must receive letter indicating sponsorship

Certification	<p>Upon successful completion of the Academy, students will meet the training requirements for the California State Fire Marshal Firefighter I. A student will then be able to apply for the Certification after successful completion of the task book and experience requirements. The California State Fire Marshal's Office has completed the National accredited certification process, approved by the Internal Fire Service Accreditation Congress (IFSAC) and the National Board on Fire Service Professional Qualifications (Pro Board). A student completing the Academy will be eligible to apply for the FFI certification upon completion. Students will also receive the following State Fire Training certificates: Fire Control 4 and Vehicle Extrication.</p>
