# Cal Fire Basic Wildland Firefighter

Yuba College Fire Technology, in cooperation with CalFire Nevada/Yuba/Placer Unit is excited to present the Basic Wildland Firefighter (BWF) class. This 219 hour BWF class will meet the minimum requirements to gain seasonal employment with CalFire. The BWF training includes: Firefighter Safety, Wildland Suppression, Structural Fire Suppression, Firefighter Survival, Confined Space Awareness and Communications. Graduates meet the minimum wildland fire training requirements need to apply for seasonal wildland fire control positions with most fire agencies in California, including CalFire.

## **PRE-REQUISITES:**

- 1. **Public Safety– First Aid & CPR** (Title 22. CA Health and Safety Code 1797.182). www.tapstraining.com
- 2. Hazardous Materials First Responder Operations: Only approved curriculum that meets or exceeds the standard will apply. CalFire, CSTI or CA State Fire Training HazMat FRO. Apply through Yuba College. Home Page Yuba College (yccd.edu)
