MATH POETRY CONTEST

What: Submit 2 typed copies of an original poem—with your contact information written on the back of each copy and your name typed on the front—that incorporates a math theme or uses language particular to or references to mathematics. All entries will be displayed as submitted. Thus, please submit poems in a typed, clean, suitable format, preferably without being folded.

Who: All Yuba College students (including those on the Clear Lake Campus, Sutter County Center, and Beale AFB Outreach) and all Woodland Community College students (including those on the Colusa County campus).

When: Poems must be *received* no later than **Thursday, March 27th, 2014**.

Where: Submit 2 copies of your poem in the marked drop box at the circulation desk in the Yuba College library. OR students from Woodland Community College or other campuses and outreach centers may send their poems to John Thoo at Yuba College, 2088 N. Beale Rd. Marysville, CA 95901.

Why: A book prize will be offered for the first place entry. Certificates will be given for first, second, and third place.
