CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR

The Veterinary Technology Program expects students to demonstrate restraint and maturity at ALL times; both in class and in their groups. - 7. The leadership team of the (Faculty) will share the responsibility of ensuring the success of the process and the quality of work advanced by the Vet Tech Team.
- 8. Learners will be good listeners listening does not require agreement.
- 9. Learners will not be critical or judgmental of the opinions, viewpoints, and perspectives of others.
- 10. It is understood that members of the Veterinary Technology Program are representatives of the College and will refrain from any inappropriate behavior that would reflect negatively on the Program or the College. At all times learners will be poised, polite, and professional.

- 12. Zero tolerance is allowed in all matters of a discriminatory nature.
