MLA Stylesheet for Research Essay Citations Yuba College Learning Resources (Revision, May 2016)

According to guidelines of the Modern Language Association, the list of sources used in a research paper is called a Works Cited list. It appears at the end of the research paper on a separate page. All entries should be double spaced. If an entry goes to a 2nd or 3rd line, those lines should be indented (hanging indent). MLA requires that you capitalize the title words in article titles and book titles. Always use a single space between citation elements.

Some general changes to note in the 8th edition of the MLA Handbook (2016): You no longer must identify the Medium of Publication. You also no longer must use the City of Publication. These are now optional elements.
