

Chicago Style Guide for Term Paper Citations

This guide was developed according to guidelines of the *Chicago Manual of Style* the foot or end notes and list of sources used in a research paper when using the “Notes” / “Bibliography” system of citation. (If you are to use the “author-date” / “reference list” system of citation, see the *Manual* for that formatting).

NOTE: All entries should be single spaced. If an entry goes to a 2nd or 3rd line, those lines should be indented five (5) spaces in for a Note and out (hanging indent) for the Bibliography.
