We will send you an email and instructions when:

- 1— The Department of Education communicates to us there is an issue with your FAFSA that needs to be resolved.
- 2 - Satisfactory Academic Progress has been run for the prior semester and you are in Warning or Terminated Status.
- 3 - Approval or Denial of Financial Aid Appeal has been determined.
- 4 - Your Financial Aid Award Letter has a new entry or has been changed.
- 5 - Financial Aid staff communicates with you about your Financial Aid file.

Forward Your Student Email

Don't miss important communications from your school !

- Forward your student email to an email account you check most often.
- 1-Log into your student email account.
 - 2-Click on Settings icon in upper right corner. Choose "Options", "Forward Your Email".
 - 3-Toward the bottom of the screen enter the address for forwarding.
 - 4-You may wish to uncheck the box directly below the entered email address that saves a copy of the email.

Are you Considering Dropping a class?

Check with your Counselor and Financial Aid Office BEFORE you drop a class. Some or all of the following may apply to you:

- Your 2nd Pell Grant payment will be adjusted to reflect your new enrollment status.
- **Dropping may result in an overpayment and you may have to repay all or a portion of your financial aid to Yuba College and/or the Federal Department of Education.**
- **If you drop and/or fail all of your classes, you will also be placed on Termination from Financial Aid.**
- If terminated, an appeal will be required to request reinstatement of your financial aid.

Did You Receive a Cal Grant?

Click on the WebGrants tab and sign in or create a record if this is your first visit to this site.

Cal Grants have not yet been added to your Award Letter. They will begin to be awarded later in September. Cal Grants are tentatively scheduled for Fall semester payment on October 10, 2014, depending on availability of funds.

Start Spring Semester with Books



Start your Spring semester with the books you need for your classes.

Save a portion of your second half Pell Grant from Fall semester to use for the purchase of books for your Spring semester.

- 1 - Better chance the bookstore will still have used and rental books available at lower prices than charged for new books.
- 2 - You allow yourself more flexibility in purchase choices.
- 3 - You will be able to do assignments from the beginning of the semester and not start the semester behind because you do not have the book.

2015-2016 FAFSA Entry January 1, 2015

You will be entering 2014 income. Enter estimated numbers if you have not completed tax returns and then return to update after filing tax return. Remember March 2 is 1st Cal Grant deadline.

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SAP Status now displays on WebAdvisor

The MyDocuments section under Financial aid in WebAdvisor has a new addition—the SAP (Satisfactory Academic Progress) status calculated at the end of the prior semester for all continuing students.
