2017-18 Board of Governors (BOG) Fee Waiver Application Instructions

BOG FEE WAIVER ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The BOG Fee Waiver waives enrollment and student service fees, if eligible. It may also waive a portion of the semester parking permit fee for the fall and spring terms. The BOG Fee Waiver does not provide assistance for books, supplies or other costs.

- Must be a California resident, an eligible AB 540 or AB 1899 student and
- Meet one of the following income eligibility criteria (Method A, B or C) listed below.
- **Important:** Effective Fall 2016 eligible students must meet academic and progress standards in order to avoid losing their BOG eligibility. For additional information, contact the Financial Aid Office.

METHOD A / SPECIAL CLASSIFICATION – If you are eligible based on one of the criteria below, you are required to provide one of the documents listed below:

TANF/General Assistance

- Notice of Action
- Welfare to Work Plan
- Printout of Passport to Services

SSI/SSP

- Certification from Social Security Administration
- Current bank statement showing the SSI direct

Special Classification

- Dependent of Disabled Veteran
- Recipient or child of a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor
- Dependent of a victim of the 9/11/01 terrorist attack
- Dependent of a deceased law enforcement/ fire suppression personnel

METHOD B - Eligibility is based on household size and total family income earned/received in 2015.

- DEPENDENT Student: Eligibility is based on parent(s) total 2015 taxed and untaxed income.
- INDEPENDENT Student: Eligibility is based on student and spouse's (if married) total 2015 taxed and untaxed income.

HOW TO APPLY FOR METHOD A OR B

- Complete the online BOG Fee Waiver application at http://www.yccd.edu/educational-services/bog.aspx. Click on the link For Yuba College Students or For Woodland Community College Students. You will complete the online BOG Fee Waiver application through CCCApply.
- Download the paper application at MyCampus Portal. Complete the application and submit to the Financial Aid Office.
- Complete the 2017-2018 FAFSA application online at www.fafsa.gov or the Dream Act application at www.csac.ca.gov/dream act.asp.

METHOD C – Eligibility is based on your 2017-2018 FAFSA or Dream Act application.

- Eligibility is based on your Cost of Attendance (COA), Expected Family Contribution (EFC) and financial need.
- Your COA is based on the housing plan you reported on your FAFSA/Dream Act application. Your EFC is listed on your Student Aid Report.
