



YUBA COLLEGE ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER

To be eligible for an "Associate Degree for Transfer" (ADT) (Associate in Arts for Transfer or Associate in Science for Transfer), students must complete the following:

- 60 CSU transferable units
- CSU GE Breadth or IGETC (Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum)
 - **Please note:** you will also need to complete Group 1C: Oral Communication for IGETC
- A major consisting of at least 18 CSU transferable units, as defined by the CCC with a grade "C" or better
 - Check Yuba College Catalog for Degree Requirements
- Minimum 2.0 grade point average (GPA)

Benefits of completing an ADT:

- *Guaranteed admission to one of the 23 CSU campuses.*
 - **Please note:** Students who earn an AA-T or AS-T degree and meet the CSU minimum eligibility requirements are guaranteed admission to the CSU system, but not necessarily to a particular campus. With the special degree, you may be given a GPA bump when applying to an impacted campus and/or an impacted major that is **deemed similar**.
- *Priority consideration for transfer admission to some of the more competitive or impacted majors and/or campuses in the CSU system.*
- *Completion of your bachelor's degree at the CSU in 60 semester units. Saves time and saves money!*
