All Degrees: 3-5 PSLOs, unless this is not practical based on program goals and objectives.	Please include 3-5 PSLOs per degree	If faculty do not follow these guidelines, have an email discussion with them about it. Explain the guidelines, and then ask them if they have a reason for giving the number listed. Make sure to rely on their discipline expertise when in doubt.
Certificate with 30-59.5 units: 3-5 PSLOs	Please include 3-5 PSLOs for certificates with 30-59.5 units.	
Certificate with 18-29.5 units: 3-4 PSLOs	Please include 3-4 PSLOs for certificates with 18-29.5 units.	
Certificate with 12-17.5 units: 2-3 PSLOs	Please include 2-3 PSLOs for certificates with 12-17.5 units.	
Certificate with 3-11.5 units: 1-2 PSLOs	Please include 1-2 PSLOs for certificates with 3-11 units.	
PSLOs are <b>not the same as CSLOs</b> or ISLOs	PSLO must be different than the CSLOs and ISLOs	Please send back to originator using “quick send back,” or coach via email and edit with approval from originator
Each PSLO includes “Actor” “Behavior” and “Context”: 1. name the people who are learning (students) 2. name the circumstances under which learning will take place 3. name what the students are expected to know or do	Please include the following language: “Upon completion of the program students will”  Please include a clear description of what you expect students to know or do.
