Yuba College's 94th Commencement Ceremony:

Friday, May 27, 2022, at 7:30 pm at the Outdoor Athletic Stadium (rain or shine)

Dear Family and Friends of the Graduating Class of 2022,

Yuba College welcomes you as our guests to our 94th Commencement Ceremony on Friday, May 27, 2022, at 7:30 pm at our Outdoor Athletic Stadium (rain or shine). This is a non-ticketed attendance and open-seating event, with the stadium opening its gates at 6:45 pm. We have close to 500 students (Class of 2022: 450, Class of 2020 & 2021: 50) participating in this year's Commencement Ceremony to receive their degree and/or certificate of achievement/training. We highly encourage that only the immediate family/friends attend to ensure every graduate has a loved one present during their ceremony.

Our Commencement Ceremony will begin on time, and we expect it to last over 3 hours. Once we meet capacity, the gates to enter will be closed. This ceremony will be **STREAMING LIVE**, and we highly encourage you to view it through our **Yuba-Events (ibm.com)** for friends and family members to view from the comfort of their homes.

Commencement Publications: will be made available at our ceremony for the Class of 2022. We will be posting these programs and programs from the Class of 2020 & 2021 on our **Graduation Website <https://yc.yccd.edu/campus/graduation/>**. Names published for the degrees and certificate of achievement/training for the Class of 2022 only include those petitioning to graduate by our April 15, 2022 deadline.

COVID-19: Our ceremony was planned according to our district guidelines. It should also be noted that California no longer has a mask mandate but strongly encourages the use of a mask.

Food: Due to the length of the ceremony and the anticipated number of guests, beverages and snacks can be purchased from the stadium concession stand, and additional snacks from Rosie's Snow Biz, which will be available outside the gates next to the tennis courts.

Website & Social Media: Updated Commencement information will be posted on our **Yuba College Graduation Website <https://yc.yccd.edu/campus/graduation/>** to include the link to streaming live on the day of the event. You can also follow us on Facebook and Instagram #yuproud on the day of the event, as students will be asked to share their day with us.

Photograph: Family members and friends are welcome to take pictures of candidates before or after commencement. Guests will be permitted to take photos from their seats only during commencement. Only graduates and event staff are allowed in the athletic surface areas. Chris Kaufman Photography will be taking individual photographs of each graduate before and after they walk off the stage. Graduating students will be receiving detailed information on how to access these photos.

Gifts for Graduates: Our Yuba College Bookstore will be selling Yuba College gear, and The Commencement Group will be selling bouquets, leis, and memorabilia at the stadium entrance.

Safety: Although Yuba College does not anticipate any security problems during commencement, we take extraordinary measures to ensure the safety of students, faculty, and guests at our events. It is encouraged that you don't leave any personal belongings in your vehicle.
