
## CONSENT

From all parties completing the FAFSA to allow the U.S. Department of Education consent to access their federal income tax information from the IRS, even if they did NOT file a tax return.



## **FSA ID**

- Every student, parent, or spouse that is required to complete a section of the FAFSA will need a FSA ID, even if they do NOT have a Social Security Number (SSN)
- Married students and parents who filed their taxes separately must each create their own FSA ID to enter information and sign the FAFSA.
- Everyone creating an FSA ID will need their own individual email address. Do not use your school email.
