- 4. Submitting work from another course unless permitted by the instructor.
- 5. Assisting anyone to do any of the above.

## **DSPS Test Proctoring Policy**

- 1. A request for test proctoring should be made at least 3 working days before the scheduled exam.
- 2. All personal belongings (purses, backpacks, electronic devices, books, etc.) must remain outside the testing room and are inaccessible during the exam period. Yuba College is NOT responsible for personal belongings.
- 3. Authorized breaks allowed if specified on your accommodation form. No time adjustments given for breaks. No food or drink (except water) allowed in exam rooms unless necessary for disability-related reasons and authorized by DSPS personnel.
- 4. All proctored exams are scheduled at the same time as the in-class exam unless other instructions are noted by the instructor on the accommodation form.
- 5. The instructor must approve any changes to the day or time of each exam.
- 6. Any make up exams are at the discretion of the instructor.
- 7. Test proctoring rooms are monitored by video cameras.
- 8. Students arriving more than 15 minutes past their scheduled test time will forfeit lost time or must contact their instructors to make arrangements to reschedule the test.
